

# PAST SIMPLE TENSE (PASADO SIMPLE)

En inglés se usa el pasado simple para:

- Hablar sobre acciones que empiezan y terminan en el pasado
  - o I bought a new car yesterday (BUY)
  - o My dad washed the dishes last night. (WASH)
  - o They were at school last year (BE (ARE))
- Acciones que suceden una tras otra en el pasado (cuando contamos una historia)
  - Once upon a time, there was a beautiful princess who lived in a big castle. One day, an
    ugly prince came to the castle because he wanted to get married with the princess,
    but the king and the queen said no way.


