The textile industry causes much of the air and water pollution on the planet. The clothing industry is the world's second largest polluter. Only the oil industry is more contaminating. One thing we can do is look for ways to repurpose old clothing. We can recycle old clothes and transform them into something that is both useful and helpful for the planet.

Remember, change starts at home. Today, we are going to make a bag from an old T-shirt.

Look at these instructions!

How to Make a Bag with an Old T-shirt

For this project you only need two things: an old t-shirt and scissors.

Materials:



To make our new bag follow these steps



1. First, cut the sleeves and the neck of the t-shirt with your scissors.



2. Then, turn the T-shirt inside out.



3. After that, cut small strips at the bottom of the T-shirt. The strips should be between 5 and 10 centimeters long.



4. Finally, tie the strips together to create the bottom of the bag. Tie them very tight!



5. Now, turn it inside out and that's it! You have a new bag you can take to the market and use instead of plastic bags.

This is a great way to recycle old clothes and take care of our planet.

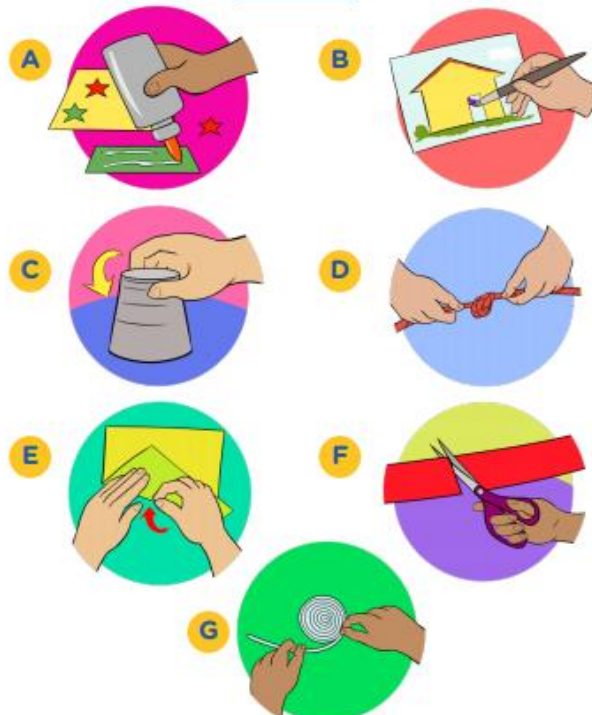

LET'S CREATE!

CREATE A LIST OF RECYCLABLE MATERIALS AND SUGGEST THINGS YOU CAN MAKE FROM THEM.

Solid waste is one of the main causes of pollution in our planet, so we have to find creative ways to recycle materials that we have at home instead of throwing them away. Make a list of the objects that usually end up in the trash. Then brainstorm ideas of new objects you can make out of these materials. In order to do that and take care of the planet, read and follow these steps:
